

Interpreting Your AEPA Score Report

1 Status

If you received a scaled total test score of 240 or above, you will receive a "Passed" status.

2 Scaled Total Test Score

If you did not meet the minimum passing score, your numeric score will be reported and you will receive a "Not Passed" status. Your total scaled test score is based on your performance on the entire test: the number of selected-response questions you answered correctly combined with any performance assignment score(s).

3 Performance Graph

Your performance on each subarea or section of the test is indicated by the graphic display. This information may help you understand your areas of strength and weakness. Interpret this information with caution since subareas contain a relatively small number of items.

4 Reporting of Scores


