

How to Read Your Score Report

General Information. This score report provides your test results for the Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessments® (AEPA®) Basic Skills test that you took on the test administration date indicated on the report. The Basic Skills test was developed for the Arizona Department of Education to provide an assessment that may be used by Arizona educator preparation programs for the purpose of assessing the basic skills of students who may be entering or admitted to an educator preparation program. Arizona educator preparation programs may require students to take the test. Passing the test is not a requirement for an Arizona teaching certificate.

Test Results. Your score report indicates your total score for each Basic Skills subtest you have taken. Your scores for the Reading Comprehension and Mathematics subtests are based on the number of selected-response items you answered correctly. Your score for the Writing subtest is based on the number of selected-response items you answered correctly combined with your score on the written performance assignment. Your score on each subtest is then converted to a score on a scale with a range of 100–300. A panel of Arizona educators has reviewed the test and provided recommendations for a passing score on each subtest; this recommended passing score is reflected by a scaled score of 240. However, each educator preparation program requiring the test will establish its own passing requirements, which may or may not be equal to the recommended scaled passing score of 240. Please contact the educator preparation program to which you are applying or have been admitted for information about that program's passing requirements.

Cautions. The test scores indicated on this report are for the purpose of assessing the basic skills of students who may be entering or admitted to an educator preparation program. These results will be reported directly to the Arizona Department of Education and the Arizona institution you indicated during registration. This score report is for your records only. Candidates who wish to retake a Basic Skills subtest may do so at any subsequent test administration at which it is offered.
